QSAC serves more than **2,500 children and adults with autism** and their families through more than **30 unique programs and services**.

QSAC offers programs and services for children and adults of **all ages (0-60+)** in more than **10 languages** other than English.




94% of preschool students graduated with functional communication skills.

Over the past year, QSAC enabled **122 adults** with autism to **attend courses at local area colleges**.



Individuals attending QSAC's Day Habilitation program volunteered more than **8,900 hours** at **121 volunteer training sites**.

QSAC supports more than **180 adults with autism** who live in a supportive apartment or supervised group home. QSAC manages **32 residences** across Queens, Long Island, Brooklyn, and Manhattan.




Our community Habilitation Program increased its capacity by **50 individuals** and Respite served an additional **35 individuals** over the last year.

Since its inception in 2015, our self advocacy group has **grown 400%**, from 15 members to more than 75 members.



QSAC's Seniors with Autism and Aging Caregivers Program is the first of its kind in the US, and provides services to **over 95 individuals**, including seniors (60+) with autism, senior caregivers, and individuals with autism whose primary caregiver is a senior.

More than 1,250 parents and family members attended QSAC trainings and support groups.



Over the last two years, QSAC partnered with 19 schools to **train 718 teaching professionals** on autism, applied behavior analysis (ABA), and how best to manage challenging behaviors.

More than 100 students and adults with autism participate in **QSAC's vocational skill development** initiatives. QSAC introduced **3 new programs** to increase our ability to provide services for job readiness, training, and placement.
